

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS PROCOPE-MOBILITY 2023

Mobility grants to France for young researchers working in Germany (Doctoral students, post-docs and research fellows)

1. Presentation et objectives

The Department for Science and Technology of the French Embassy in Germany wants to strengthen Franco-German cooperation in research and innovation by supporting the mobility to France of doctoral students, post-doctoral fellows and other young researchers, which are members of a laboratory or a research institute located in Germany. These mobility grants will allow researchers working in Germany to carry out a research stay in a laboratory or research institute located in France.

2. Duration of stay

The mobility grant will finance a stay of **one to three months**. The mobilities will take place **between May 1 and December 31 2023**.

3. Amount of the mobility grant

Laureates of the program will receive a fixed sum of €1600 per month for doctoral students and €2100 per month for post-docs and other young researchers, plus transport costs. The mobility grant will be paid through an agreement established between the laureate and the French Embassy, to the bank account indicated by the grantee in the said agreement.

4. Host institution

The organization that accepts to receive the candidate is a laboratory or a research institute located in France, which will be responsible for making all the necessary arrangements for the stay of the grantee, if necessary.

5. Eligibility requirements

Any non-French doctoral student, post-doctoral fellow or young researcher, within a limit of 7 years after the defense of the thesis, affiliated with a German research organization, can apply for this mobility program, which encompasses all areas of research.

6. Application submission

The application file must be sent **before March 26, 2023** in pdf format to the following address: attache-science.berlin-amba@diplomatie.gouv.fr

The application file, written in German, English or French, will include the following elements:

- An information sheet (to complete below)
- A CV (two pages maximum).
- A letter of motivation including a precise description of the research project. The desired duration of the research stay must be justified.
- A letter of recommendation from the thesis supervisor or a doctoral degree.
- A letter of confirmation from the host laboratory.

Only **complete files** respecting the requested form will be examined, on the criterion of the relevance of the stay for the candidate's research project.

The results will be communicated on Thursday, April 13, 2023.

7. Activity report

Grantees of the mobility program must send an activity report of a maximum of two pages, detailing their achievements during their stay, in German, English or French to attache-science.berlin-amba@diplomatie.gouv.fr.

8. Policy of the French Embassy

As part of the "Green Embassy" ("Ambassade verte") program, the French Embassy wants to promote sustainable mobility: The grantees will, as far as possible, be encouraged to use environmentally friendly means of transport.
