Procope-Mobilität

General principle:

- **Procope-Mobilität** supports the mobility to France of **young researchers (PhD candidates to max. 7 years after PhD)** working in a research institute or university in Germany.
- **All scientific fields** are covered by this programme.
- Specific calls for:
 - High technologies,
 - European Universities alliances.
- French people, including those with dual nationality, are **not eligible**.

Organization:

Procope-Mobilität is funded and implemented by the **French Embassy in Germany**.

Funded:

- Mobility grants for research visits to France lasting **between one and three months**,
- **1,600€/month** for doctoral students and **2,100€/month** for other researchers.

Procope (PHC/PPP)

General principle:

- **Procope** supports the development and strengthening of scientific exchanges between French and German research units.
- **Involvement of young researchers** in the programme is a condition for applying.
- **All scientific fields** are covered by this programme.

Organization:

Procope is implemented in France by **Campus France** and the **French Embassy in Germany** and in Germany by the **DAAD**.

Funded:

- Repeated short-term exchanges **over a period of 2 years**

General information:


- **Procope+** supports:
 - Meeting (or series of meetings) or workshops,
 - Scientific colloquium or conference.
- Events must take place in **Germany** or **France** within **12 months**.
- Projects may include a **third partner** from another European country.
- **All scientific fields** are covered by this programme.

Organization:

Procope+ is implemented in France by **Campus France** and the **French Embassy in Germany** and in Germany by the **DAAD**.

Funded:

- **Material costs** associated with organizing the event,
- **Subsistence** and **travel** allowances,
- ~6000€ funded on each side (French and German).
